Dear Parents,

We trust that you are keeping well and that our learners are up to date with their school work.

Remember that all flip-file work must be revised thoroughly on an ongoing basis. Learners must also be encouraged to read daily for at least **fifteen minutes**. Encourage them to read ALOUD.

All **Term 4 Blue Rainbow Book** (BRB) pages must be completed by home-based learners at home. **Answers to be done in BRB.**

Parents are requested to ensure that school-based learners are punctual for school and arrive before 7.40am. Learners must also be reminded to follow all Covid-19 protocols when attending school.

Please note:

- **All home-based learners will report to school for both oral and written assessments from the 16th to 26th November 2020. They must attend school on alternate days according to the groups they belong to, from 7.30 am and be dismissed at 12.45pm.**
- An Assessment Plan has been included, kindly refer to it. **All learners** will have to produce a medical certificate if they are absent for any of the assessments. The assessments will not be conducted on another date if learners stay absent for trivial reasons. Learners will be penalised if the reason for absence is not valid.
- All oral assessment activities for English, Afrikaans and isiZulu have been provided to learners.
- A video has been provided for isiZulu.

- All home-based learners will report to school for both oral and written assessments

Kindly ensure that learners come to school thoroughly prepared for oral and written assessments (refer to dates on the Assessment Plan). As this is the final term and it is an extremely short one, it is imperative that learners attend school and avoid absenteeism on their respective days till the end of the term. Remediation of assessments, as well as completion of the syllabus will continue after assessments are complete, to ensure that learners cover any gaps in their knowledge.
