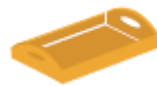

a suffix is a group of letters added to the end of a root word.

example:

slow + ly = slowly

The snail slid slowly over the leaf.

Suffixes - ly

Using the suffix - ly

If the word has a silent e, just add on the ly

love+ly= lovely	nice+ly= nicely
late+ly= lately	scarce+ly= scarcely
safe+ly= safely	brave+ly= bravely
wise+ly= wisely	like+ly= likely

If the word ends in a y, change it to an i, then add ly

busy+ly= busily	lazy+ly= lazily
cheeky+ly= cheekily	easy+ly= easily
greedy+ly= greedily	sneaky+ly= sneakily
crazy+ly= crazily	crafty+ly= craftily
lucky+ly= luckily	happy+ly= happily
