Remember point to the numbers, as you count, for number recognition. When you return to school, you are going to be tested on random number recognition.

**Bonds:** Revise your Bonds up to 10.

Hope you are revising all concepts done earlier. ( halving, doubling, before, after, more, less, number lines, money story sums , grouping, sharing, number sequencing etc)

Today, we are going to learn more about Bonds. **Building up numbers:**

This is how we do it. Some of you will be able to do it without drawings. That means you have a thorough knowledge of your Bonds. That's good! If not then you can draw. I'll show you how.

Eg.  $3 + \underline{\quad} = 5$  Simple, just work from numbers you have already. **3 and 5**. So you draw 5 pictures and put a line after 3. So what's left over is your missing number or your answer.

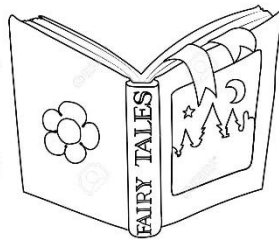
 so  $3 + \underline{2} = 5$

**Now try these: Only Addition until you master them.**

$4 + \underline{\quad} = 6$     $5 + \underline{\quad} = 7$     $1 + \underline{\quad} = 4$     $3 + \underline{\quad} = 7$     $\underline{\quad} + 2 = 9$     $\underline{\quad} + 4 = 8$     $9 + \underline{\quad} = 10$     $5 + \underline{\quad} = 8$

Now try more on your own.

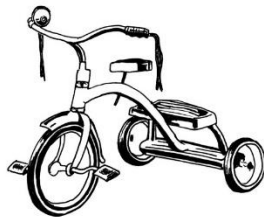
