Wednesday 22 July 2020

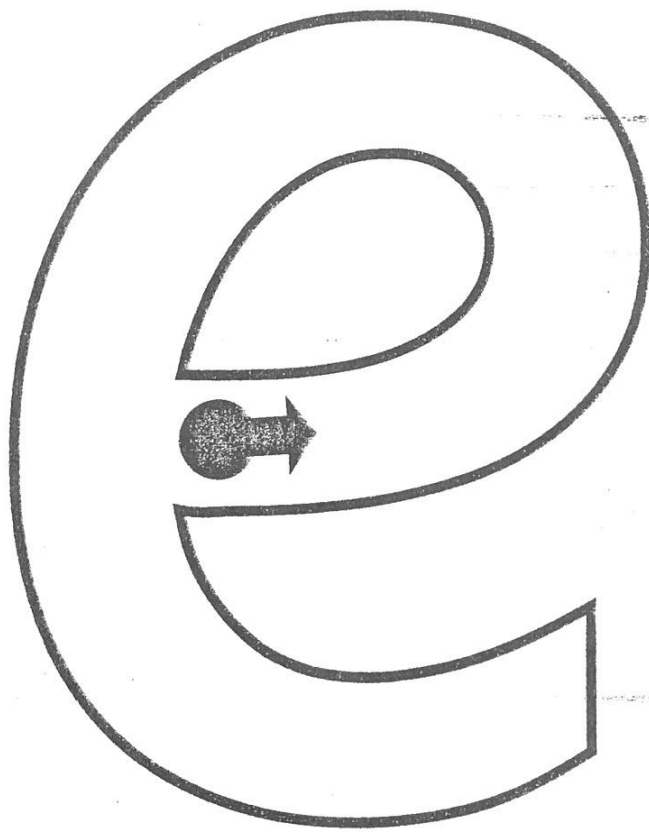
- Sing the nursery rhyme 'head, shoulders, knees and toes' and point to each body part accordingly.
- Draw a picture of yourself.

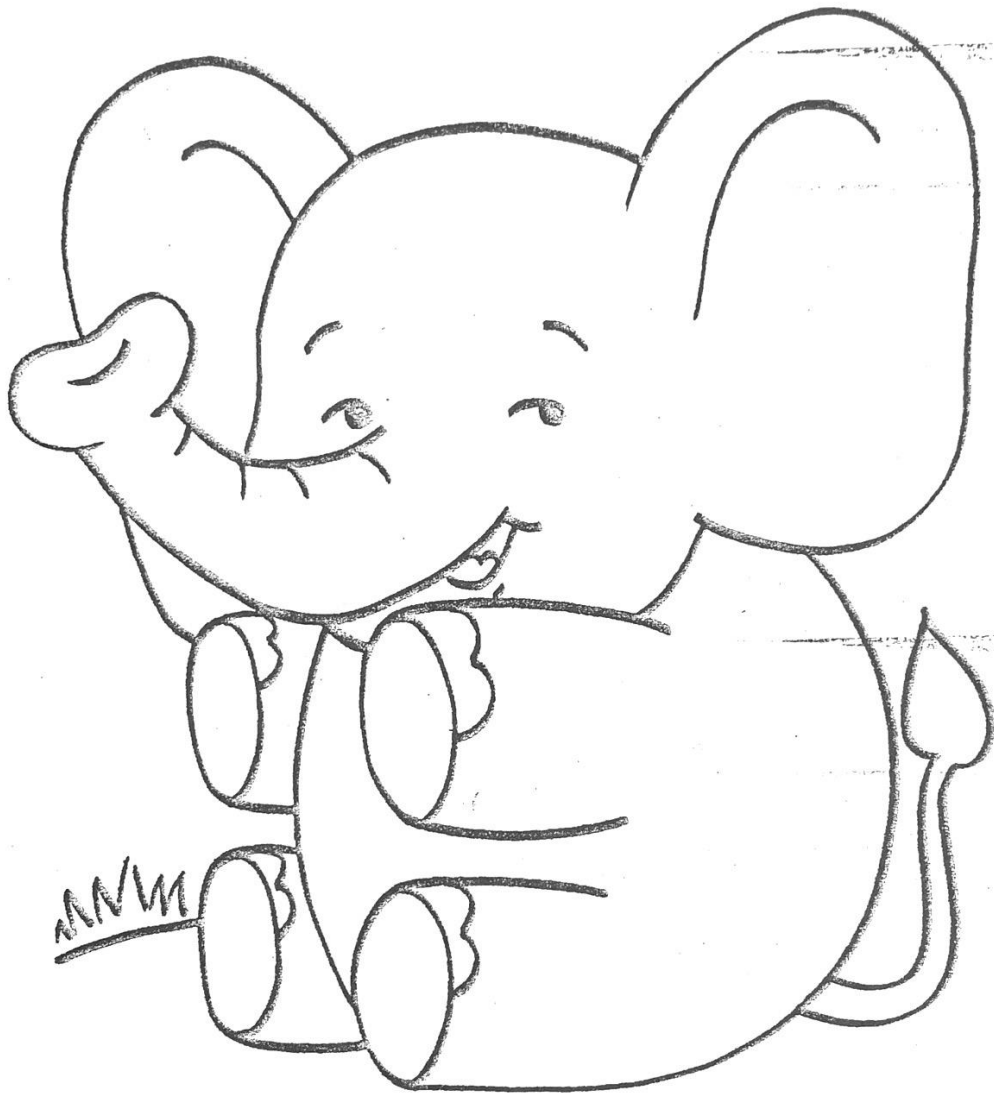
Thursday 23 July 2020
