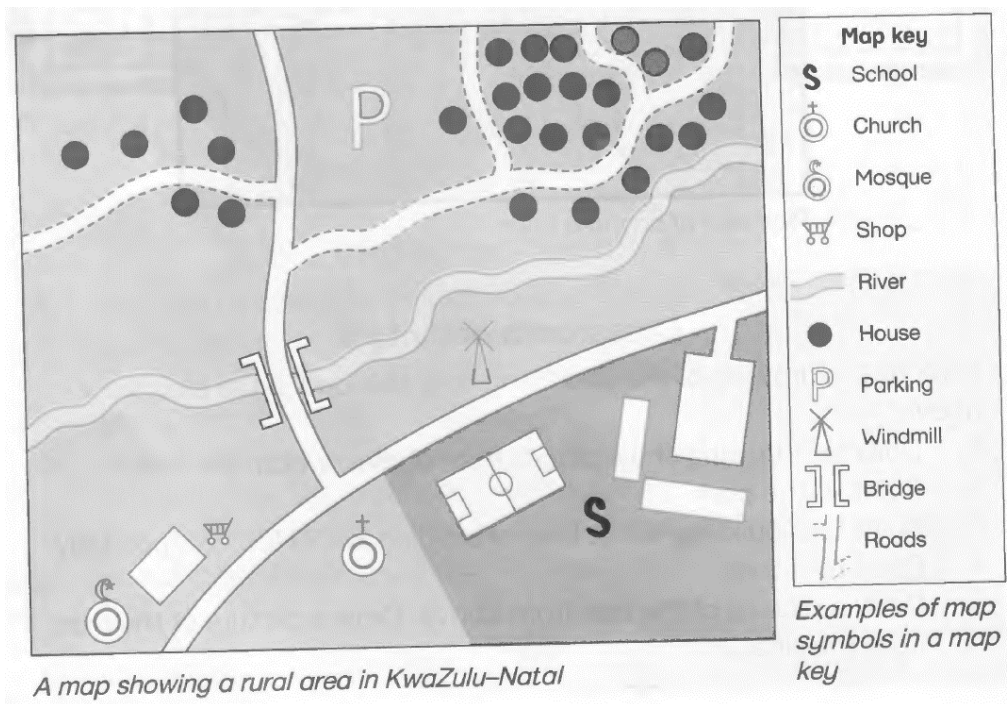


REVISION - Symbols and Keys

1. Symbols and map keys

We use little drawings, letters, lines and words on maps to help us read the map. These are **map symbols**.

We explain the meaning of map symbols in a box next to the map. This is the **map key**.

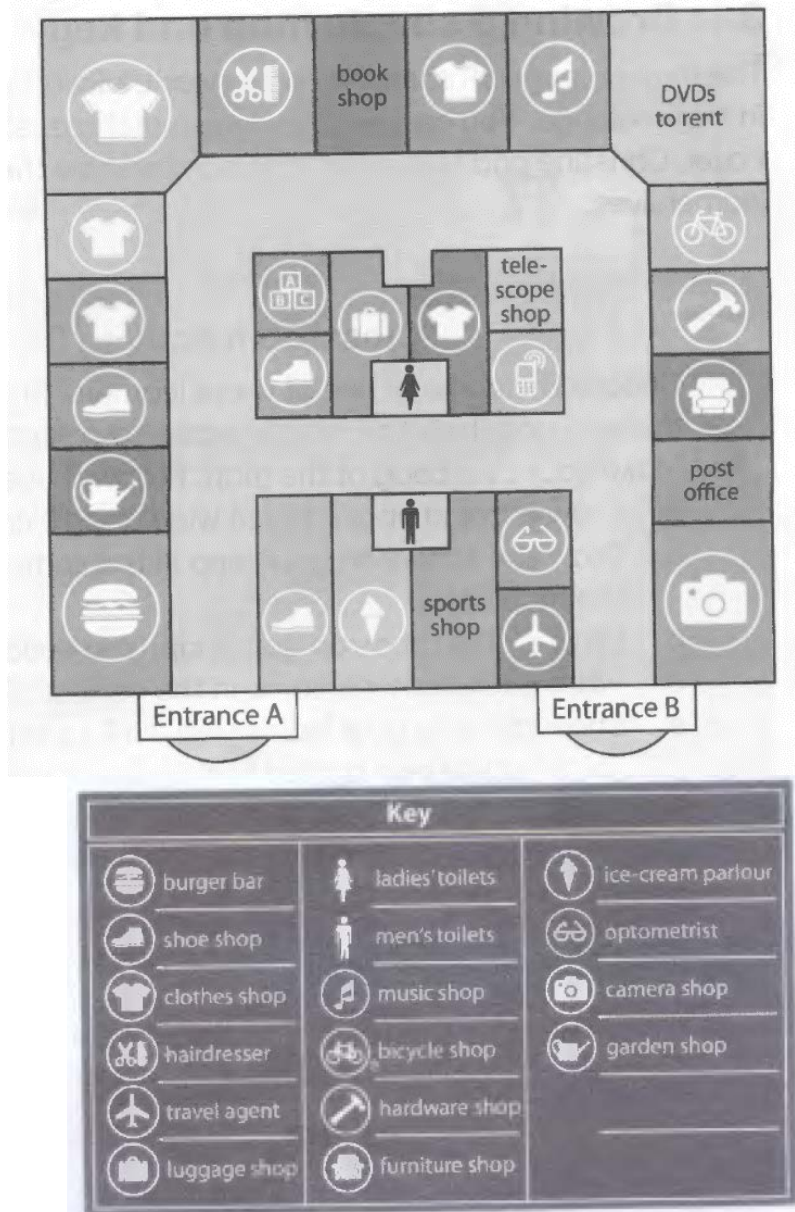


Activity 1

1. Point to the places on the map where there are houses.
2. Draw the symbol for a house
3. What does the ⊖ symbol represent?
4. Find the symbol that uses a letter instead of a drawing. Write this symbol in your book. What does the symbol represent?
5. Find a symbol that is a line on the map. Draw this symbol in your book.
6. Name 3 objects you will pass if you walk on the road from the school to the mosque. Draw the symbols for the three objects.

2. Reading symbols on a map

The drawing below is a simple map of a shopping centre. Look at all the symbols in the map key.



Activity 2

1. Draw the symbols that show clothes shops, a hardware shop and a shoe shop.
2. List the shops you would pass between the Burger Bar and the toilets.
3. Draw the symbols of all the shops you will pass on your right between entrance B and the music shop.
4. Draw your own symbols for the bookshop and for the sports shop.
