Instructions

Choose a religion that is followed in South Africa. You can choose your own or a different religion that you have studied. You are required to research the religion and include the following information:

- Their religious beliefs and what they worship
- Holy books or messages from Prophets
- Significant places or buildings of worship
- Religious or spiritual leaders
- Methods and times of worship
- Special Days and festivals
- Foods which are permissible and food which is forbidden
- Traditional clothing and accessories
- Special rituals in regards to birth, puberty, marriage and death
- Other interesting information about the religion

* First plan your project. Parent/siblings are allowed to help in the planning phase only.

* To find information, you can interview people, use newspapers and books, your worksheets or you can use the internet. Gather as many pictures as possible.

*Each learner needs to summarize and write out his/her own information carefully and neatly. Only the cover page, content page and headings will be allowed to be printed using a computer or with adult assistance. If your assignment is not written in your own handwriting, you will be asked to rewrite the assignment, under teacher supervision.

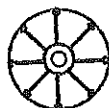
* Include different colours, fonts, pictures or drawings to make it interesting, understandable and more presentable.
