Animals in Art

In this topic, we will be studying animals in their natural environments! Have you ever looked at the way a cat stalks a bird, or felt the texture of the coat of a horse or a cow? Many artists specialise (become really good at one thing) in drawing, painting or sculpting animals, or taking photographs of them. Refer to page 130 of the Life Skills book and read the notes given.

1. Study the pictures in the textbook carefully thereafter, complete activity 19.1 on page 131.
2. Refer to page 132. Read the notes on wild and domestic animals. *A wild animal lives in its natural environment and finds its own food. A domestic animal is looked after by people, on farms or as pets in their homes.*
3. Complete activity 19.3 (**Draw and paint an animal in its environment**) on page 133. This activity is a drawing/ art activity. Ensure that you have all the tools needed before you begin. Your drawing does not have to be perfect, as long as you have attempted the activity. Ask your parent to read all the steps/ instructions in your textbook before you begin.
