WHAT IS A POSTER?

It is a large printed sheet that often contains pictures and is posted in a public place. The reason is to educate or inform the public about any useful information or events.

Guidelines for drawing a poster:

1. Read and understand what the topic is.
2. The poster must have interesting information and facts about the topic.
3. The poster must have a large and eye-catching picture or image which is linked to the topic.
4. Posters usually have slogans (sayings) which attract the reader's attention.

Instructions:

1. Draw a poster to create awareness about bullying.
2. Your poster should have approximately 80-90 words in total.
3. Write a draft copy e.g. a mind- map to plan your poster.
4. Be sure to edit the draft by checking your spelling and grammar.
5. Your poster should contain information about bullying that readers would find useful. E.g.,
 - What is bullying?
 - Types of bullying that occur
 - How to overcome bullying.
 - Who should you talk to if you are being bullied?
