Then the Grasshopper knew...

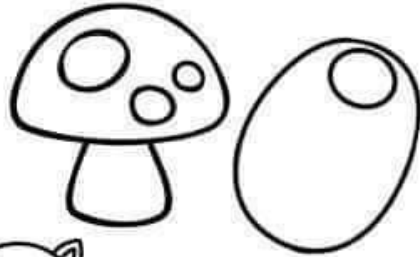
