one word that names a group of
people, animals, or things

An **army** of soldiers



A **team** of ducks



A **bunch** of keys

PREFIX	MEANING	EXAMPLE
un	not; reversal of	uncover
re	again; back	review
in / im	in; into; not	instead impatient
dis / dif	away; separate; not	divide disrespect
en / em	in; within; make	enslave embolden
pre	before	prefix
mis	wrong	mistaken
a	not; in, on; without	atypical aside

SUFFIXES

- COME AT THE END OF A WORD
- CHANGE THE MEANING

SUFFIX	MEANING	EXAMPLE
-s, -es	more than one; verb maker	characters, reaches
-ed	in the past; quality, state	walked
-ing	doing something; quality, state	walking
-ly	how	safely
-er, -or	one who; action; compares	drummer dishonor bigger
-tion, -sion	noun: quality, action	tension
-able, -ible	able to be	reversible
-al, -ial	related to, like	partial
