Lesson: **Mobiles and Stables**

What is the difference between a Mobiles and a Stables?

Mobiles

Mobiles are moving sculptural artwork. They are often made with colored metal pieces connected by wire rods. Mobiles have moving parts that are sensitive to a breeze or light touch. Mobiles can hang from the ceiling. Mobiles can be used for interior decoration e.g. in a baby's bedroom, in the grade R classroom etc.

Stables

A stable is an abstract construction that is stationary. The term **stationary** distinguishes them from mobiles. It sits on the ground but not made to move freely. Organic and geometric shapes are used to make the stables just like the mobiles. Repetition of lines and foams are used.

Similarities.

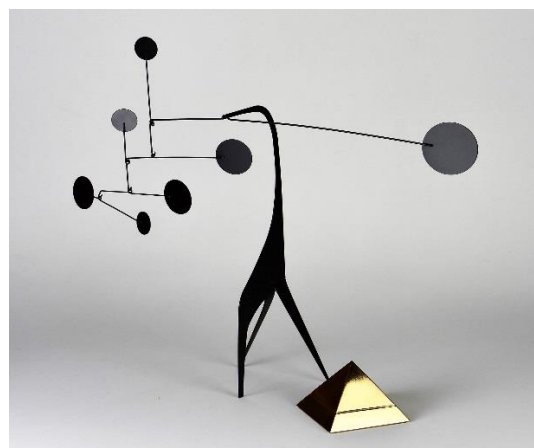
Different colors are used on both. Different shapes are used on both.
