Monday 13 July 2020

- Revise numbers 1-5 by counting out objects in your room. Eg: 1 bed, 2 pillows, etc.
- Complete Blue Book Page 48- count the fingers and match it to the correct number. Trace the numbers 1-5

Tuesday 14 July 2020

- Count out 6 objects in your bedroom.
- Count the leaves on the worksheet and colour them in. Trace and colour in the number 6.
- Count the butterflies on the worksheet. Colour the number 6 and butterflies. Trace the number 6. Remember to hold your pencil using the correct pencil grip.

Wednesday 15 July 2020

- Complete Blue Book Page 49- discuss what the children are doing and tick the correct picture for time of day of activity.
- Colour in the worksheet showing day and night. Trace the words and read them with your mum or dad.

Thursday 16 July 2020

- Read the number names one – five and sound out each name. Match the name to the number symbol.

Friday 17 July 2020

- Complete Blue Book Page 52- cut out the chart and attach the hands. Turn it to show the different times of day. Read the words 'morning', 'afternoon', 'evening' and 'night'.

Daily maths oral

- Count forwards and backwards 0 to 20
- Count in 2s to 20
- Count in 5s to 30
- Count in 10s to 50
- Revise numbers 1 to 7. Show the value of each number eg: clap 5 times
- Say the days of the week/months of the year/seasons
- Say what day is today, what day was yesterday and what day will tomorrow be

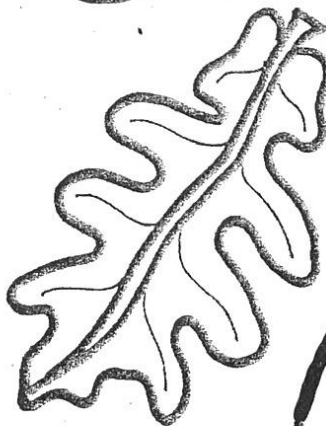
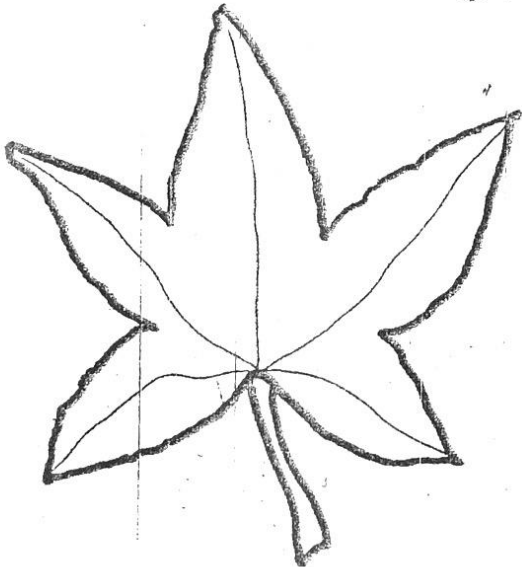
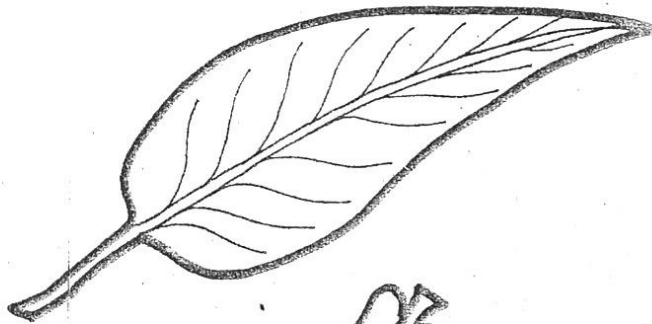
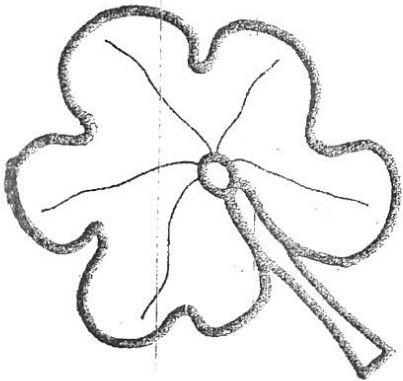
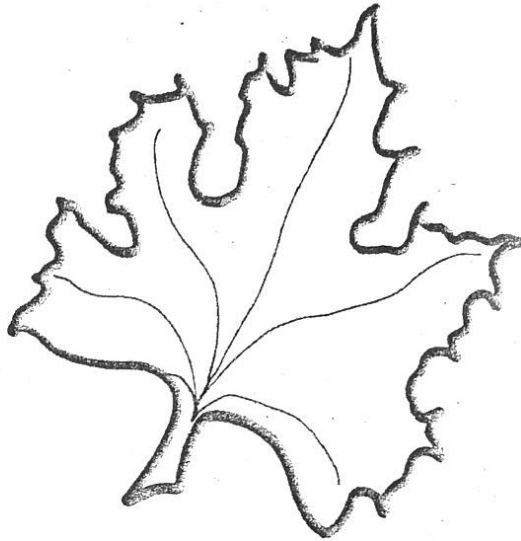
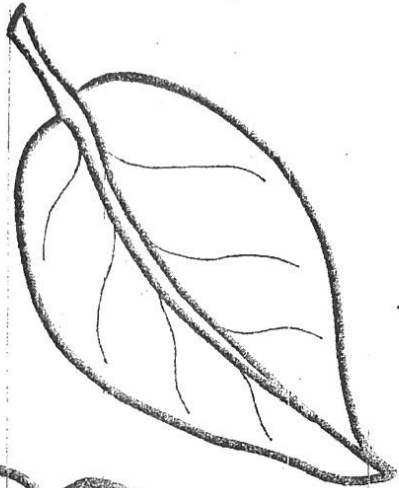
Remember to practice your Covid rules- practice social distancing, wear a mask if you are going out and wash your hands regularly for 20 seconds.

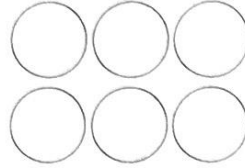



