





"What is that?" she asked. She was very scared.


"Run! Run!" said City Mouse. "It is the house cat and she will eat you if she catches you."


The next morning Country Mouse said she was going home. City Mouse was very sad. "You have only been here for one night. Why are you going home so soon?"
